



NRA\4-H .22 PISTOL POSTAL MATCH

The purpose of this postal match is to offer all 4-H members an opportunity to participate in a nationwide pistol postal competition.

MATCH CONDITIONS

ELIGIBILITY

An individual may enter this match only once during a calendar year.

FIRING DATES

Firing may be done any time after firing reports are received from the Competitive Shooting Division.

ENTRY CLOSING DATE

Entries may be made any time provided targets and firing reports are returned to NRA by December 27th.

Current NRA Conventional Pistol Rules will govern. NRA Rule Books are now available on line at: http://www.nrahg.org/compete/nra-rule-books.asp or by calling NRA Sales at 1-800-336-7402 request item #CP16650.

EQUIPMENT

.22 caliber pistol or revolver may be used. See NRA Pistol Rule 3.4.

DISTANCE - 50 feet.

TARGETS

Targets will not be provided by the NRA. They may be acquired locally or NRA will provide a list of target manufacturers on request. Targets required are as follows:

Slow Fire **B-3** Timed Fire 2 Rapid Fire 2 **B-3**

SCORING

All targets will be scored by the sponsors and/or competitors. Scores will be reported to NRA on the score sheets provided. Targets are no longer required. Please send only the completed score sheets.

COURSE OF FIRE - 60 shots

TIME LIMITS

Slow fire - 2 strings of 10 shots, 10 minutes per string. Timed fire - 4 strings of 5 shots, 20 seconds per string.

Rapid fire - 4 strings of 5 shots, 10 seconds per string.

WITNESS

Shooting will be under the supervision of an adult leader acting as official witness.

\$5.00 per competitor. All entry fees are used to offset the costs of the postal program.

AWARDS

WINNER - A trophy plague with Postal Logo and final score engraved will be mailed to the highest scorer in each category. Second through fifth place will receive awards based on participation. There must be a minimum, in each category overall, of two competitors to award first place, five competitors for second and ten competitors for third.

PLEASE NOTE

It is the responsibility of the competitors to check their scores as listed in the online results and to notify the statistical officer (Dian Bullock at: dbullock@nrahq.org) of any errors or omissions prior to the expiration of the challenge period. The challenge period time frame will be listed in the results. At the conclusion of the challenge period all scores are final and no changes to the results are allowed. (See appropriate NRA Rule Book, Sections 16 and 18.).
