NRA NATIONAL JUNIOR CLUB SMALLBORE RIFLE POSTAL MATCH

This series of four matches is fired during the winter months. The winning team of each match is determined by the aggregate score of all four series. An individual award will recognize the highest scoring shooter in each series.

AWARDS

At the conclusion of the four month series, each winning team in each match will receive awards according to the following schedule.

TEAMS

3 teams	1 set of awards
10 teams	2 sets of awards
15 teams	3 sets of awards

1st Place 1st & 2nd Place 1st, 2nd&3rd Place

INDIVIDUALS

Individual awards will be awarded to the highest scoring shooter in each series.

ELIGIBILITY

Matches 1, 2 and 3 are open **only** to Junior Clubs **not** sponsored by a Secondary school and have affiliation with NRA.

Matches 4, 5 and 6 are open **only** to Junior Clubs sponsored by Secondary school or JROTC Unit who are affiliated with NRA.

The team match is an unfired match generated by the fired scores of four (4) participating individuals. All **Sub-Junior shooters must comply with NRA Rule 2.3.2 and all Junior shooters with rule 2.3.** Individuals eligible to compete at the beginning of the series may complete the same as originally entered.

No shooter may fire as a member of more than one team entered in the same match during the same monthly series. Team members may be changed from match to match provided they meet the eligibility requirements.

ENTRY DATE

Entries and fees must be received by NRA not later than December 1. All targets must be fired and postmarked by April 2nd. No targets will be accepted after this date. Make entries to:

FIRING DATES

One set of targets will be fired for each series. Targets may be fired in advance of the stated month, if so desired. All targets are to be marked so that the particular monthly series is indicated on the firing report as follows:

1st Series - Dec 31 2nd Series - Jan 31 3rd Series - Feb 28 4th Series - Mar 31

COURSES OF FIRE

MATCH 1: 4-Position for Junior Clubs. Each firing member will shoot 10 shots in the PRONE, SITTING, KNEELING AND STANDING position at 50 feet using the A-17 target. Time limit -- 1 minute per shot prone, sitting and kneeling; 1.5 minutes per shot standing.

MATCH 2: 3-Position for Junior Clubs. Each firing member will shoot 10 shots in the PRONE, STANDING, AND KNEELING position at 50 feet using the NRA USA 50 target. Time limit -- 1minute per shot prone, 1.5 minutes per shot kneeling, and 2 minutes per shot standing.

MATCH 3: Sub-Junior PRONE for Junior Clubs. Each firing member will shoot 20 shots prone for every match at 50 feet using the NRA USA 50 target. Time limit -- 1 minute per shot.

MATCH 4: 4-Position for all High School teams (JROTC or not). Same course of fire as Match #1.

MATCH 5: 3-Position for all Non-Military High School Clubs. Same course of fire as Match #2.

MATCH 6: 3-Position for all Military Scholastic (JROTC) Clubs. Same course of fire as Match #2.

RULES: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle rules will govern.

ADMINISTRATION

Target Seals are no longer required.

Before firing starts, targets must be identified for use during the postal match. To do this, competitors will initial the back of the target behind the #1 scoring bull's-eye; or you have the option of placing a label on the back of the target behind the #1 scoring bull's-eye.

Score all targets in accordance with section 14 of the NRA Smallbore Rifle Rule Book. Targets are no longer required. Please send only the completed score sheets to NRA.

EQUIPMENT/SPECIFICATIONS

.22 Caliber rim fire rifle (NRA SB Rifle Rule 3.2)

Metallic sights must be used.

Unlimited sighting shots are permitted. All sighting shots must be fired within the time limit.

WITNESS

All shooting will be under the supervision of an adult club leader acting as the official witness for the entire match.

SCORING

Each target is to be scored by two club instructors who score the same target at the same time according to rule 14.3. Both instructors must agree on the exact value of the shot hole. If they disagree, a scoring plug must be used. If both instructors still disagree, a third party must break the tie. All shots visually close to any scoring ring must be plugged. The total target score is then entered on the target label and initialed by the two instructors.

Clubs will keep the targets for 90 days AFTER the results appear online. Targets are kept for challenges and/or tie breaking purposes.

Instructors should keep a copy of the Scoring Report Form for their records.

BREAKING TIES

Winners in each match are determined by aggregate scores. If aggregate scores are tied they will be broken by first comparing scores in the last series, if still tied, by comparing scores in the third series, etc. If a tie still exists after all series scores are compared, NRA Rule 15 will be applied.

PLEASE NOTE

It is the responsibility of the competitors to check their scores as listed in the online results and to notify the statistical officer (Dian Bullock at: <u>dbullock@nrahq.org</u>) of any errors or omissions prior to the expiration of the challenge period. The challenge period time frame will be listed in the results. At the conclusion of the challenge period all scores are final and no changes to the results are allowed. (See appropriate NRA Rule Book, Sections 16 and 18.).Competitors and sponsors are responsible for the content of this program and the following of all rules and instructions.
