

# NRA/Royal Rangers BB Gun Postal Match

## Purpose

The purpose of this postal match is to offer Royal Rangers throughout the country an opportunity to participate in a nationwide BB Gun Postal Match.

## Prerequisite

Recommended that Firearm Safety and Marksmanship merits be complete.

## Eligibility

An individual may enter this match only once per calendar year. All competitors must be a member of a current chartered outpost.

## Categories

Each age group will comprise a category. Youths ages 8 through 15 may compete in this postal match.

## Team Match

The team match is an unfired match generated by the fired scores of five participating individuals. The team category will be determined by the age of the oldest team member. Any number of teams may be entered by each outpost (must indicate the number teams on entry form).

## Awards

**Individuals** — The First Place winner in each age group 8 through 15 years of age will receive a plaque engraved with the postal logo. Second through fifth place will receive awards based on participation. Additional awards will be provided for each additional ten competitors in an age group. First place in each category for each position will also be awarded. Second through fifth place will receive awards based on participation. Additional awards will be provided for each additional ten competitors.

**Team** — National trophy plaques will be provided for first place in each category. One additional plaque award will be provided for each five additional teams.

## Firing Dates

Competition will commence on January 1 of each calendar year and will end on October 31. All targets must be returned and postmarked by November 15.

Firing may be conducted any time after score reporting forms are received from NRA.

## Fees

**Individual** — \$5.00 each; **Team** — \$15.00 each. Each shooter will receive a participation certificate. All team members must enter as individuals.

## Rules

Current **NRA BB Gun Rules** will govern this competition. Rule books are available at the NRA Online Store at [www.nrahq.org](http://www.nrahq.org) or from NRA Sales at (800) 336-7402. Ask for item number #CC16410.

## Equipment

The Daisy 499 series BB gun will be used.

## Targets

AR-4/10 targets (5-meter, 10 bullseyes). Please print the shooter's name and shooting position in the upper right hand corner of each target. Target acquisition is the responsibility of the competitor. NRA official targets are required. For a list of licensed target manufacturers call (703) 267-1482.

## Course of Fire

Ten shots will be fired from 5 meters in each of the three positions, one shot per record bulleye: Prone, Standing, and Kneeling, There must be a total 30 shots fired for the match.

Ten minutes will be allowed to fire all ten shots for each position. Unlimited sighting shots are permitted, but must be fired within the ten minute time limit.

## Scoring

Each target must be scored by two individuals and in accordance with NRA BB Gun Rules. All targets are subject to review and rescoring by the NRA.

## Match Conditions

Eye protection is required during this event by the Royal Rangers.

## Administration

Complete the entry form attached and return to the Competitive Shooting Division. You will receive individual and team score reporting forms to record the match scores and individual participation certificates. Return targets, reporting forms, and entry fees to the NRA (*see next page for address*).

## Match Bulletin

The NRA will compile a match bulletin and provide one to each address on the entry form. The bulletin will specify national and category winners and also provide rank listing of all competitors according to categories. Royal Rangers will publish results on the Royal Ranger Web site.

**Results will be available after December 15.**

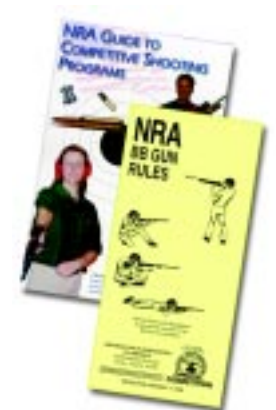
