Look for Winnequah Gun Club sign and Indoor Range on your left. Go through the gate and past the building. Follow the road to the High Power Rifle Stat Office. **ELIGIBILITY:** Open to anyone.

Fees paid by those unable to attend will be refunded upon request providing cancellation is made prior to 6:00 pm, Friday September 15, 2017. There will be no refunds for those canceling after that time.

**ENTRIES CLOSE:** 6:00 pm Friday, September 15, 2017. Entries after this time are considered late entries and may be accepted to fill vacancies on existing relays only. An additional \$20.00 will be charged for late entries. Individual entries are limited to 192 competitors, and 32 Teams.

**TARGET SERVICE:** With the Electronic Target system competitors are still required to score. Any competitors failing to perform his scoring duties may be disqualified. Personal Smart phones or Kindle laptops can be used for scoring. Competitors **WILL NOT** pull targets. **NO MORE BUS RIDE!** 

**EMPTY CHAMBER INDICATOR (ECI):** Approved NRA empty chamber indicators are required to be used at all times except during the preparation period time and firing. Those not having an ECI may purchase one at the Stat Office for \$1.00 each.

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. Scorecards for individual matches will be issued at the Stat Office starting at approximately 6:30 am. Any competitor who fails to obtain scorecards by 7:30 am will only be squadded to fill vacancies.

**DIVISION BY RIFLE:** F-Open and F-TR.

**AWARDS:** Medals and cash awards will be given. Award groups must contain a minimum of 5 competitors in class and category or they will be combined with the next appropriate award group per policy. Second, third, fourth place etc. awards will be given based on one award for every seven (7) competitors, i.e second 8-14, third 15-21, etc. Team awards will be based on classification for setting National Records only.

**SPECIAL INDIVIDUAL AWARDS:** In the High Woman, High Senior, and High Grand Senior awards will be given if there are 5 or more entries in each category. In the Grand Aggregate a High Junior award will be given if there are at least 2 Juniors.

**CHALLENGE PERIOD:** The challenge period ends ½ hour after posting of the match results.
