Rules: Current NRA Smallbore Rifle Rules will govern.

ELIGIBILITY: Open to all competitors, **membership in the NRA is NOT required.**

Teams will consist of 2 or 4 firing members (as determined by the sponsor and stated in the program), a captain and/or coach if desired, and will represent either a club, Rule 2.11 or 2.11.1, a law enforcement agency, Rule 2.14, a Regular Service Unit, or a Reserve unit (including National Guard) Rule 2.13. The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team.

ENTRIES:

At least eight (8) individual entries must be reported to NRA for a Regional Championship. Tournaments with less than eight competitors will NOT be considered as Regional Championships.

Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made by using the enclosed registration entry card, accompanied by check or money order. Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA classification and NRA membership number if you have one. If you are not a NRA member, a number will be assigned to you later by the NRA Tournament Reporting Department, for classification purposes only.

Entries Close: Individual Match entries must be received no later than Monday preceding the opening date of the tournament. Team match entries close at _____ of the day the team matches are fired.

Entries Limited: Entries are limited to _____ competitors.

Post Entries: Post entries will be accepted up to the stated limit of the range provided such entries will not require the squadding of extra relays.

TIME OF FIRING: Firing will commence each day at:

SOUVENIR PINS: Will be given to each individual who competes.

RIFLE: Any Rifle Rule 3.2

TARGET: NRA Official Targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

CHALLENGES: A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (NRA Rule Book Section 16).

SQUADDING: All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done by the Statistical Office. Competitors are responsible for proof of classification. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on range. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

CLASSIFICATION: The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. **NRA classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class Rule 19.2. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.4 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament.

AWARDS: To the Winner, 2nd, and 3rd place overall, a medallion (provided entries warrant). To the winning team 1st place team, medals to each firing member. Awards are furnished by the NRA. The tournament sponsor **will** provide other awards for all **fired** matches and **aggregates**. Sponsor will post on the bulletin board an award schedule after entries have closed and before the tournament begins. (Generally at least 50% of match entry fees should be given in awards to the class/category winners.)

CLASS AND CATEGORY: NRA will provide a medal to each class winner with a minimum of five (5) in the class. National Championship entry fee credit certificates will be provided, see page 3 for schedule.

SPECIAL AWARDS: Optional (Senior and Junior) – An individual winning a place award shall be entitled to Special Awards for which he or she is qualified, but may not win a category/class award in the same match. Such awards will be passed down to the next eligible competitor. To be eligible for a Special Award the individual must indicate on his or her entry card the groups represented.

CLASS AWARDS: Optional (after the winner in each class is provided for) -- The category/class awards will also be passed down, as described above, if an individual is the winner of a Special Award.

REGIONAL AWARDS SCHEDULE

GRAND AGGREGATE

Winner:	NRA Regional Gold Medallion (with a minimum of 8 shooters)
2 nd Place:	NRA Regional Silver Medallion (with a minimum of 10 shooters)
3 rd Place:	NRA Regional Bronze Medallion (with minimum of 15 shooters)

AWARDS FOR FIRED TEAM MATCHES - METALLIC SIGHT AND ANY SIGHT

For the winning team, a 1st place team medal will be awarded each firing member.

INDIVIDUAL MATCHES

All firing will be done on A-51 or A-50 targets

Matches may be fired on one day or two days, per sponsor preference. If fired over two days, iron sights may be fired the first day and any sights may be fired the second day. -- Half course (60 shots-- 20 shots in each position) is also allowed.

20 Shots at 50 Yards/Meters, and with Any Sights– on the A-51/A-50 target.
20 Shots at 100 Yards, and with Any Sights – on the A-33 target.
- No. 4 40 Shots, 100 Yards, and with Any Sights – on the A-33 target.
