**Rules:** Current NRA Smallbore Rifle or NRA International Rifle Rules will govern.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Open to all competitors, **membership in the NRA is NOT required.**

Teams will consist of 2 or 4 firing members (as determined by the sponsor and stated in the program), a captain and/or coach if desired, and will represent either a club, Rule 2.11, 2.11.1, a law enforcement agency, Rule 2.14, a Regular Service Unit, or a Reserve unit (including National Guard) Rule 2.13. The team captain and/or coach may be firing members of the team.

**ENTRIES:**

At least eight (8) individual entries must be reported to NRA for a Regional Championship. Tournaments with less than eight competitors will NOT be considered as Regional Championships.

Individuals: Entries in individual events will be made by using the enclosed registration entry card, accompanied by check or money order. Circle the number of each event in which you wish to fire. Be sure to indicate your correct NRA classification and NRA membership number if you have one. If you are not a NRA member, a number will be assigned you, for classification purposes only.

Entries Close: Individual Match entries must be received no later than Monday preceding the opening date of the tournament. Team match entries close at \_\_\_\_\_ of the day the team matches are fired.

**TIME OF FIRING:** Firing will commence each day at:

**SOUVENIR PINS:** Will be given to each individual who competes.

**RIFLE:** Rule 3.2

**TARGET:** NRA Official Targets will be used (Section 4, NRA Rules).

**CHALLENGES:** A challenge fee of \$1.00 will be charged for each challenge made. (NRA Rule Book section 16).

**SQUADDING:** All matches will be squadded. Squadding will be done by the Statistical Office. Competitors are responsible for proof of classification. Squadding information for team matches will be announced on range. A competitor who fails to present himself at the proper firing point when his relay is called may lose his right to compete in that event.

**CLASSIFICATION:** The NRA classification system will be used in all matches. **NRA classification cards may be checked by the Statistical Officer.** Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master Class. Rule 19.6 - Assigned Classification, or 19.2 - Temporary Classification, may be used in making entry in an NRA Regional tournament.

**AWARDS:** To the Winner, 2<sup>nd</sup>, and 3rd place overall a medallion (provided entries warrant). To the winning team 1<sup>st</sup> place team medals to each firing member. Awards are furnished by the NRA. The tournament sponsor **will** provide other awards for all **fired** matches and **aggregates**. Sponsor will post on the bulletin board an award schedule after entries have closed and before the tournament begins. (Generally at least 50% of match entry fees should be given in awards to the class/category winners.)

**CLASS AND CATEGORY:** NRA will provide a medal to each class winner with a minimum of five (5) in the class. Camp Perry entry fee credit certificates will be provided, see page 3 for schedule.

**SPECIAL AWARDS: Optional** (Senior and Junior) --An individual winning a place award shall be entitled to Special Awards for which he or she is qualified, but may not win a category/class award in the same match. Such awards will be passed down to the next eligible competitor. To be eligible for a Special Award the individual must indicate on his or her entry card the groups represented.

**CLASS AWARDS: Optional** (after the winner in each class is provided for)-- The category/class awards will also be passed down, as described above, if an individual is the winner of a Special Award.

NATIONAL RECORD CHECKLIST

When applying for NRA National Records the following procedures MUST be completed for a record to be validated by the NRA Headquarters.

- 1. Does competition exist (i.e., more than one competitor or Team)?
- 2. Is the competitor an American Citizen (Smallbore, Pistol)?
- 3. Is the competitor an NRA Member or a Junior Member of an affiliated NRA Club?
- 4. Was the competition sanctioned by the NRA as an NRA Registered tournament?
- 5. Did the competitor fire the score in an individual Match (Individual Record)?
- 6. Did team members fire as a unit in the same tournament or Sectional?
- 7. Are the required forms completed and certified by the proper individuals? 
  - Official Registered Tournament Report 
    - a) Was a Referee or the three Jury members listed? (Note: A Referee or Jury MUST be assigned in all Registered tournaments. See Note in c) below)
  - NRA National Record Reporting Form 
    - a) Is the course of fire correctly identified on the National Record Reporting Form (Rule 17.5)?
    - b) Are the correct category/s identified? (Section 2) (Note: NRA Headquarters can only consider what is identified on the NRA National Record Reporting Form. Headquarters staff will not add Categories to the National Record Reporting Form)
    - c) Did the Referee or Jury Member (In High Power it must be the Jury Chairman) sign the National Record Reporting Form? (Note: The Referee or a member of the Jury, identified in the Official Registered Tournament Report, MUST certify the record. Under no circumstances may any Match Official (Match Director, Statistical Officer, Range Director, or Target Officer) be a member of the Jury)
    - d) Did the Statistical Director submit and sign the NRA National Record Reporting Form?
    - e) If no Records were established, was the form still completed?
  - Final Tournament Results Bulletin, at least one copy is being provided? (Match numbers must be indicated (per Program). Awards must be given for a match to receive national record recognition.)
- 8. Did you include the correctly scored targets? (Note: Smallbore, Air & BB Gun only; scoring will be validated and targets rescored, if necessary.) Electronic target tapes showing 10 shot strings must be sent.

This checklist is provided to help with the processing of NRA National Records. The NRA Rule Book is the primary source for each of the steps and should be consulted if there are any questions.
