

BUTTERMAN TROPHY



The Butterman Trophy is a sterling silver trophy cup manufactured by the Manchester Silver Co., Inc. The 14 inch high cup is mounted on a marble base with engraving ring. The trophy was presented to the NRA in 1983 in memory of CPT Ronald F. Butterman, USA, who lost his life in a scuba diving accident in March of 1981. In his brief shooting career Ron became the 1980 Indoor International 3-Position Sectional National Champion with a score of 1179. The trophy was purchased by his friends and fellow competitors and donated for the Championship.

Awarded to the Indoor International Rifle 3-Position Sectional National Champion. Redesignated in 2016 to the winner of the NRA Intercollegiate Rifle Club Championships Individual Air Rifle Championship.
