

2025 NRA Long Range National Championship

Range Location

Facilities

Please note that the range does not have running water or electricity. Portable toilets will be available at the match. There is no camping allowed on the range property.

Entries

The National Long Range Championships are open to all competitors. Membership in the NRA is not required, but highly recommended. Competitors who are not NRA members are not eligible for National Record recognition. Unclassified competitors will compete in the Master class category.

Registration

Advanced registration is required. Registration will open on March 15, 2025. All registration must be done online via www.targetscore.com . Entries will be limited to 100 competitors. Registrations over 100 will be placed on a waitlist with notification once an opening has become available. All entries must be paid at the time of registration (except team matches where fees will be collected prior to the matches). Entries will close on June 15, 2025.

Rules

Current NRA High Power Rules will apply.

Firearms Allowed

Service Rifle, Rule 3.1 or Any Rifle, Rule 3.2, or Palma Rifle, Rule 3.3.1

Targets/Scoring

Shot Marker Electronic Targets will be used. Competitors should bring an electronic device with sufficient power for a full day of operation with browser capabilities. With the use of electronic targets, competitors are still required to score. All competitors are required to read and understand the e-target resolution process that will be handed out in your competitor packet.

Squadding

All matches will be squadded in advance. All scorecards will be issued in advance and will be placed in the competitor packet. Packets can be picked up the morning of July 2nd. More details will be provided to competitors prior to the beginning of the match.

Each shoot-off participant will fire 3 sighting shots and 10 shots for record. Time limit: 13 minutes.

Procedures in case of ties in the shoot-offs

The tie will be settled with an additional 5 shot shoot off counting X's which will be shot in 5 minutes with no sighters. If it is still tied, it will then go to another 5 shots, with no sighters until the tie broken.
