# Registration

Advanced registration is required. Registration will open on March 15, 2025. All registration must be done online via <a href="www.targetscore.com">www.targetscore.com</a>. Entries will be limited to 100 competitors. Registrations over 100 will be placed on a waitlist with notification once an opening has become available. All entries must be paid at the time of registration (except team matches where fees will be collected prior to the matches). Entries will close on June 15, 2025.

# Targets/Scoring

Shot Marker Electronic Targets will be used. Competitors should bring an electronic device with sufficient power for a full day of operation with browser capabilities. With the use of electronic targets, competitors are still required to score. All competitors are required to read and understand the e-target resolution process that will be handed out in your competitor packet.

# **Squadding**

All matches will be squadded in advance. All scorecards will be issued in advance and will be placed in the competitor packet. Packets can be picked up the morning of July  $2^{nd}$ . More details will be provided to competitors prior to the beginning of the match.
