Junior: Born 1999, 2000, 2001
Intermediate Junior: Born 2002, 2003, 2004
Sub-Junior: Born 2005

Team Match

Teams: Teams will consist of four (4) members. A competitor may NOT fire on more than one team in each discipline. (A competitor may be on a team in the Precision Championship and on a team in the Sporter Championship). [The team match is a paper match.](#)

Team Categories: Teams are entered in categories according to the age of the oldest member of the team.

Awards: For 3-Position Precision and Sporter AND Precision and Sporter Standing
First, second and third place overall individuals.
First place overall team
First place to the High Scoring Junior
First place to the High Scoring Intermediate Junior
First place to the High Scoring Sub-Junior

3-POSITION PRECISION AND SPORTER AIR RIFLE

Course of fire

Match Day 1: Individual Match - 20 shots prone, 1 minute per record shot.
7:30 – 12:30 Individual Match - 20 shots standing, 5 minutes.
Individual Match - 20 shots kneeling, 1 minute per record shot.

Match Day 2: Individual Match - 20 shots prone, 1 minute per record shot.
1:00 – 5:50 Individual Match - 20 shots standing, 25 minutes.
Individual Match - 20 shots kneeling, 1 minute per record shot.

Rifle: Rule 3.1.

Positions: Rules 5.6, 5.10 and 5.12.

Sights: Rule 3.7.

Distance: 10 meters.

Sighting Shots: Rule 9.2. The time allotted for sighting shots will be 8 minutes for the first set of targets or position, and 5 minutes for each set of targets or position thereafter.

Tie Scores: Ties will be broken using Rule 15.

Audible timing devices are not allowed.

PRECISION/SPORTER AIR RIFLE STANDING

Course of Fire:

Match Day 1: Individual Match - 60 shots standing,
1:00 -5:30 STAGE 1: 20 shots 25 minutes
STAGE 2: 20 shots 25 minutes
STAGE 3: 20 shots 25 minutes

Match Day 2: Individual Match - 60 shots standing,
7:30 – 12:30 STAGE 1: 20 shots 25 minutes
STAGE 2: 20 shots 25 minutes
STAGE 3: 20 shots 25 minutes

Rifle: Rule 3.1.

Positions: Rules 5.6, 5.10 and 5.12.

Sights: Rule 3.7.

Distance: 10 meters.

Sighting Shots: Rule 9.2. The time allotted for sighting shots will be 8 minutes for the first set of targets or position, and 5 minutes for each set of targets or position thereafter.

Tie Scores: Ties will be broken using Rule 15.

Audible timing devices are not allowed.
