

NRA NATIONAL JROTC POSTAL MATCH

Instructions - Please read carefully

Targets: AR-5/10 targets are required. Only one shot is fired on each record bull's-eye. The Orion Scoring System is approved.

Target Seals: Are not required. Before firing, have the cadet sign the back of the target behind the #1 scoring bullseye.

Distance: 10 meters.

Course of Fire - Sporter: 3-Position: 10 shots each position; prone, standing and kneeling.

Course of Fire - Precision: 3-Position: 10 shots each position; prone, standing and kneeling.

TIME ALLOWANCE:

The time allotted for sighting shots will be 8 minutes for the first set of targets or position, and 5 minutes for each set of targets or position thereafter. Record time is 1 minute per record shot prone and kneeling; and 15 minutes for all 10 shots standing.

Witness: All record firing must be witnessed by a JROTC unit official.

In order to maintain the highest possible standards in all NRA sponsored or co-sponsored postal matches, the NRA reserves the right to investigate unusually high scores submitted by competitors of unknown ability (no current shoulder-to-shoulder classification on file, etc.). The NRA also reserves the right to observe a firing of substantiating scores. This refiring will be accomplished on NRA registered targets in the presence of an NRA appointed witness.

Failure on the part of the competitor in individual matches or the coach in team matches to cooperate will result in disqualification. Failure to approximate the original scores when the substantiating scores are fired will result in the NRA recording only the substantiating scores.

Administration: Each target must contain a label affixed to the front of the target in the upper right corner. The label must contain school name, school city and state location, shooter's name, shooter's academic year firing position and target score initialed by the two scorers.

Scoring: Each target is to be scored by **two JROTC instructors** who score the same target at the same time. Both instructors must agree on the exact value of the shot.

Indicate **Sporter or Precision match**.

Enter academic year as: 1 for Freshman, 2 for Sophomore, 3 for Junior or 4 for Senior for each participant.

NEW for 2020: More than one team may enter but no individual may fire on more than one team per year.

Coaches will retain all targets until 30 days after the final results are posted on the web.
