



## MATCH 1

### Match Conditions Smallbore Rifle Junior Individual Postal Match

- Course of fire: 30 shots: 10 shots each position: prone, standing and kneeling in the order listed.  
Distance: 50 feet from the firing line to the target.  
Firing may be indoors or outdoors.
- Equipment: Any .22 caliber rimfire rifle, which conforms with the additional restrictions in rule 3.2 of the NRA Smallbore Rifle rulebook, is permitted.  
The use of a sling is permitted.  
Only Metallic sights may be used.  
All firing will be done by single cartridge loading. For safety reasons, the use of a clip or magazine is not permitted.  
Use of spotting scopes for observing targets may be used.
- Targets: A-17 targets are required.  
Only one shot is fired on each record bull.
- Target stickers: Are no longer required. Have each competitor sign or initial each target on the back of the target behind the #1 scoring bullseye before firing.

Please note: If an individual is firing as a member of a team and has entered in the individual match, he/she will be firing two matches in December, one as an individual entry and one as a team member.
