Match Conditions Precision Air Rifle Adult Individual Postal Match

- Course of fire: 30 shots: 10 shots each position: prone, standing and kneeling in the order listed.
Distance: 10 meters (33 feet) from the firing line to the target.
Firing may be indoors or outdoors.
- Equipment: Any type of compressed-air or CO2 rifle of conventional appearance, which conforms with the additional restrictions in Rule 3.1 of the NRA Precision Air Rifle Position rulebook, is permitted.
Only Metallic sights may be used.
Use of spotting scopes for observing targets may be used.
- Targets: AR 5/10 targets are required.
Only one shot is fired on each record bull.
NRA official targets are required.
- Target stickers: Official target stickers are no longer required. Each competitor will sign or initial the back of each target behind the #1 scoring bullseye before firing.

Please note: If an individual is firing as a member of a team and has entered in the individual match, he/she will be firing two matches in December, one as an individual entry and one as a team member.
