

WEST POINT LEADERSHIP TROPHY



The West Point Leadership Trophy was donated by the West Point Pistol Team in 2011 and is to be awarded annually to the collegiate pistol team with the overall highest aggregate score for the open events at the NRA Intercollegiate Pistol Championship.

The Eagle atop the trophy is a proud and noble symbol for our nation and it was felt this would be a most appropriate component of a trophy awarded to the National Championship Pistol Team. The helmet clutched in the eagle's talon is the helmet of Pallus Athena and symbolizes higher learning. The shield clutched in the eagle's other talon has long been a symbol for protection. The words inscribed on the shield are Latin for Duty Honor Country - West Point's motto. As Americans, we all have a sacred duty to serve our country honorably and, in so doing, protect the freedoms that make our country great.

The West Point Pistol Team hopes the athletes and coaches of all collegiate pistol teams will strive to be leaders of character for our nation as they compete to win this trophy.
