

ENLISTED MEN'S TROPHY



The Enlisted Men's Team Trophy is a 44-inch-high bronze statuette of a Marine enlisted man. It was purchased by the voluntary contributions of the enlisted men of the Marine Corps and presented to the NRA in 1910 for annual competition between teams of enlisted men.

Match Conditions:

- 1911 Competition among teams representing the various armed services. Each team consists of six enlisted shooters, two alternates, Team Captain and Coach. Each firing members will fire 10 shots slow fire, standing at 200 yards and 10 shots slow fire prone at 600 yards with the Service Rifle
- 1937 10 shots slow fire standing at 200 yards, 10 shots rapid fire sitting or kneeling from standing at 300 yards.
- 1940 Teams of 10 firing members – need not be enlisted team.
- 1952 Teams of four firing members – not restricted to Service teams.
- 1954 May be fired with either the Match or Service Rifle.
- 1978 Four-member Service teams shooting the Service Rifle. 10 shots slow fire standing at 200 yards; 10 shots rapid fire at 200 yards, sitting or kneeling from standing' 10 shots rapid fire at 300 yards, prone from standing, 20 shots slow fire prone at 600 yards for each firing member.
