

BAUSCH AND LOMB TROPHY

The Bausch and Lomb Trophy is an equestrian statuette by the famous Western sculptor and artist C.M. Russell. It was presented to NRA in 1933 by the Bausch and Lomb Optical Company, to be awarded to the High National Guard Team competing in the Herrick Trophy Team Match. With the exception of one year (1966), when it was fired as an individual match, the trophy has been awarded to a team, when it was in competition. The match conditions are the same as those for the Herrick Trophy Team Match, 1000 yards in Long Range High Power, fired at the NRA National Championships.

Match Conditions:

- 1933 - Competition between teams of eight firing members, two alternates, Team Captain and Coach. 15 shots per firing member at 800, 900 and 1000 yards on the "C" target, prone slow fire with the Free Rifle.
- 1935 - Course of fire reduced to 10 shots per firing member at 800 and 900 yards, and 15 shots per firing member at 1000 yards.
- 1936 - Team composition reduced to six firing members, Team Captain and Coach. Course of fire changed to 20 shots per firing member at 1000 yards.
- 1966 - Conditions changed to make the Trophy an individual trophy, 20 shots for record, metallic sights, at 1000 yards.
- 1967 - Conditions changed back to those specified in 1936.
- 1976 - Conditions changed to reduce the number of firing members to four. Target changed from the "C" target to the LR decimal target.
- 1979 - Conditions changed to allow two sighting shots per firing member; presentation made for the first time to the High Reserve Component Team (including National Guard).
- 2017 – National Matches moved to Camp Atterbury, Edinburg, Indiana
