The Herrick Trophy is a massive and ornate silver cup presented to the NRA in 1907 by the Honorable Myron T. Herrick (1854-1929), Governor of Ohio, 1903-1906, Ambassador to France 1912-1914 and 1921-1929.

Match Conditions:

1907 - Ohio Rifle & Pistol Association Match. Competition between teams of eight firing members, two alternates, Team Captain and Coach. 15 shots per firing member at 800, 900 and 1000 yards prone position with the Free Rifle.

1920 - Converted to NRA Trophy, same course of fire.

1935 - 10 shots per firing member at 800 and 900 yards and 15 shots at 1000 yards.

1936 - Team of eight firing members, two alternates, Team Captain and Coach. 20 shots per firing member, 1000 yards prone position with Free Rifle.

1954 - Team of six firing members, two alternates, Team Captain and Coach. 20 shots per firing member, 1000 yards prone position with any rifle.

1976 - Team of four firing members, 20 shots prone at 1000 yards with any rifle, any sights.

2017 - National Matches moved to Camp Atterbury, Edinburg, Indiana
